

Factory: **Nebraska Fence Company**

Location: Corner of 19<sup>th</sup> & 1<sup>st</sup> Ave, south of the tracks

Years of operation:

March 22, 1890 – Company formed to manufacture wire fencing

Apr. 16, 1890 – Load of wire and slats received. Men being trained on machines

Description of procedures.

Apr. 19, 1890 – New 2-story building finished today. Will produce a wire & slat fence.

Hardwood pickets dipped in oil and galvanized wire. Start manufacturing tomorrow

Apr. 22, 1890 – Fence factory now in production

Oct 23, 1891 – Has again been in production for the past two weeks. Was affected by the hard times last year but is back in business

Feb 25, 1893 – Has moved from the old laundry building to the building west.

Jan. 1, 1899 – Unidentified account book has balance for Nebraska Fence Co. of \$29.20

Oct. 5, 1900 – Homer J. Allen died. He was president of the Nebraska Fence company.
